Read on to find out how we, the Office of the Data Protection Authority (ODPA), will process your personal data if you choose to enter our competition.



It's all about you

'Personal data' is any information about who you are or what you do.

If you choose to enter this competition, we will collect and use information about you just so we can identify the winner.

To do that the <u>only</u> information we need is: Your name Your tutor group Name of your school




It's up to you!

We collect and use this information with your consent.

This means that you do <u>not</u> have to give us this information or enter the competition if you do not want to.

(So if you do not provide us with this information, we will not enter you into the competition.)



Changed your mind?

No problem - before the winner of the competition is decided you can tell us that you no longer want us to use your personal data collected for this competition.

If you do this we will stop using your personal data, and we will remove your entry from the competition.


Winner's regret?

If you win the prize and accept it, sadly we cannot withdraw your entry afterwards.

How long will we keep your details?

All personal data collected will be deleted once the competition has ended, and we promise we will <u>not</u> use it for anything else.

Your ideas will be kept for promotional use and for use in schools, but we will <u>not</u> say whose ideas they are.



Know your rights

The Data Protection Law gives you 10 rights over how your personal data is used.

The rights that apply to our use of your personal data for this competition are:




 Right of access – you can ask us for a copy of your personal data that we are using.



 Right to rectification – you can ask us to change the personal data we are using.



• Right to erasure – you can ask us to delete your information.



 Right to restriction of processing – you can ask us to only use your personal information for certain reasons.
